Team Member Training: A brand new training track offered in response to an overwhelming demand by team members. Come and fine tune your skills, network with other team members and senior trainers, improve your FAST knowledge, and learn best practices. This is a full two day training - January 24-25, 2011 with Pre-K sessions held additionally on Wednesday, January 26, 2011 until noon.

Pre Certification Seminar: This training track is for individuals who wish to become Certified FAST Trainers. Attendance at all five days of training is required in order to qualify to become a trainer-intern. Trainer certification will be good for three years after completion of the internship. January 24-28, 2011.

Secondary Certification Seminar: This track is for Certified FAST trainers who would like to become certified in another FAST version. This is a full two day training - January 24-25, 2011 with Pre-K sessions held additionally on Wednesday, January 26, 2011 until noon.

Re-Certification Seminar: This track is for Certified FAST trainers who wish to maintain their certification or to sharpen their skills as a trainer/local director. Certified FAST trainers must attend re-certification training every three years in order to maintain certification. This is a full two day training - January 24-25, 2011 with Pre-K sessions held additionally on Wednesday, January 26, 2011 until noon.

Discovery FAST Training: This track is for individuals or agency representatives who wish to learn more about the FAST program, gain an understanding of the implementation process. This is a full two day training - January 24-25, 2011 with Pre-K sessions held additionally on Wednesday, January 26, 2011 until noon.
