Buddy Time	The team includes Buddy Time as one-to-one adult time every week for 15 minutes with parents setting the agenda; parents take equal turns to listen (married couples are together). Single adults rotate between partners in order to meet at least 3-4 new adults over the course of the FAST cycle.	Buddy Time occurs every week for less than 15 minutes; no turn- taking/listening structure monitored.	Buddy Time every week with the team setting topic/agenda. Special Presentation	Topic is chosen by parents during the 3rd week session. The high school students are the target audience for the presentation, but it is done with all the families together. Graduation	Graduation Ceremony theme is driven by parents. Principal is asked to participate in ceremony with parent permission. Personalized affirmations are read within the Parent Group. Parents write affirmations for youth. At parents' discretion, guests are invited to participate in FAST Graduation. Family certificates are presented to family through the parent(s).	Parents decide not to have a Graduation Theme. Neither principal nor guests attend the FAST Graduation. An additional week was used to conduct the graduation ceremony and complete surveys.	Parents are not given a choice about a graduation theme; team makes this decision. Team does not prepare personalized affirmations to read in Parent Group. Guests are allowed within Parent Group without participating parent permission being given. All of the FAST Components were not done on graduation night (excluding additional week added).

Parent Group	Parent Partner and Community Partner co-facilitate Parent Group for 45 minutes (no staff paid by the school is present); parents set their own topics and agenda; no new members after week 3; 3 to 10 per parent group; mothers meet in hub groups; fathers meet across the hubs; grandmothers meet across hubs; priority of gender/ culture match to lead groups. Children activity time (60-75 minutes) facilitated by school staff, teachers, community representatives, volunteers, and recreational supports. Positive structured supervised activities are offered, with choices for small groups which are developmentally appropriate and positive and creative time; some quiet, some active physically; babies are held.	Parent group is less than 40 minutes per week; more than 10 people in the room; no gender or culture match by parent group facilitator. Mentors of youth participants may also participate in Parent Group. Mentors may also hold a separate group if there are 2 or more attending sessions.	The team facilitates weekly Parent Group but with school personnel present and/or there is no parent partner in parent group. Or Parent Group is conducted less than every week. Or Didactic lectures or lead topics to teach parents in the group.
